1. Junior Competitors are 11 years of age and under; Intermediate Competitors are 16 years of age and under; Open Competitors are 17 to 60 years of age; Senior Competitors 61 years of age and over.
2. All entrants are asked to arrive at 1:00 p.m. and report to the office to obtain position for judging.
3. Time limit - not more than three minutes. However, a player may use less time if desired.
4. Contestants must play a Waltz (3/4 time), a Jig (6/8 time) and a Reel or a Hoedown (2/4 time) and in the given order.
5. Tunes must be accepted old time tunes.
6. In the case of accident beyond a player's control (e.g. broken string), he or she may replay.
7. An accompanist will be provided. However, the player may bring his or her own accompanist, any one instrument, who may play melody or chord. A keyboard will be available.
8. In the event of a tie, the committee will judge one with highest points on the "reel".
